## Analysis of student's feedback Session: 2021-22

A total of 133 responses were received from the students. On being asked if the course content is up to date in comparison to similar program / courses from other institutions, 57.1% stated that the course content was up to date, while 19.5 % students felt that the course content, though up to date, had scope of improvement. The rest of the students felt that the question was not relevant at all. About 70% students felt that the courses offered were useful in enhancing one's employability. 66% of the students felt that course curriculum was flexible in terms of optional/ elective/ CBCS courses. Around 68% students felt that the courses offered reflected the needs and aspirations of the society. 71.4% students stated that they feel the program pursued by them is going to help them in the career they want to choose. 68.4% of the students felt that the delivery of the course/ program would have been much better, had there been a strong industry-academia collaboration. 15.8% opined that industry-academia collaboration would have made the delivery of the course/ program better to a large extent, while 9.8% students believed that the current semester system may not allow adequate course coverage. About 73.7% students stated that the acceptance of the course/ program would have been much better if there was a strong alumni intervention in terms of training and placement activities of the department/ college. About 12.8% students also felt the same to quite an extent, while 7.5% believed that the current semester system may not allow adequate course coverage. On being asked to rate the facilities/ infrastructure of the college for extracurricular activities and personality development on a scale of 1 to 10, 40% students rated the facilities/ infrastructure to be in between 8 to 10 and felt that the facilities were very good while 47% students rated in between 4 to 7 and saw a chance of improvement in the above aspects. About 13% of the students rated in between 1 to 3 and felt that there was a huge scope of improvement in terms of the facilities/ infrastructure provided.
