1. One Day Career Guidance Workshop at AKHS Institution, North Guwahati (27.08.2022)

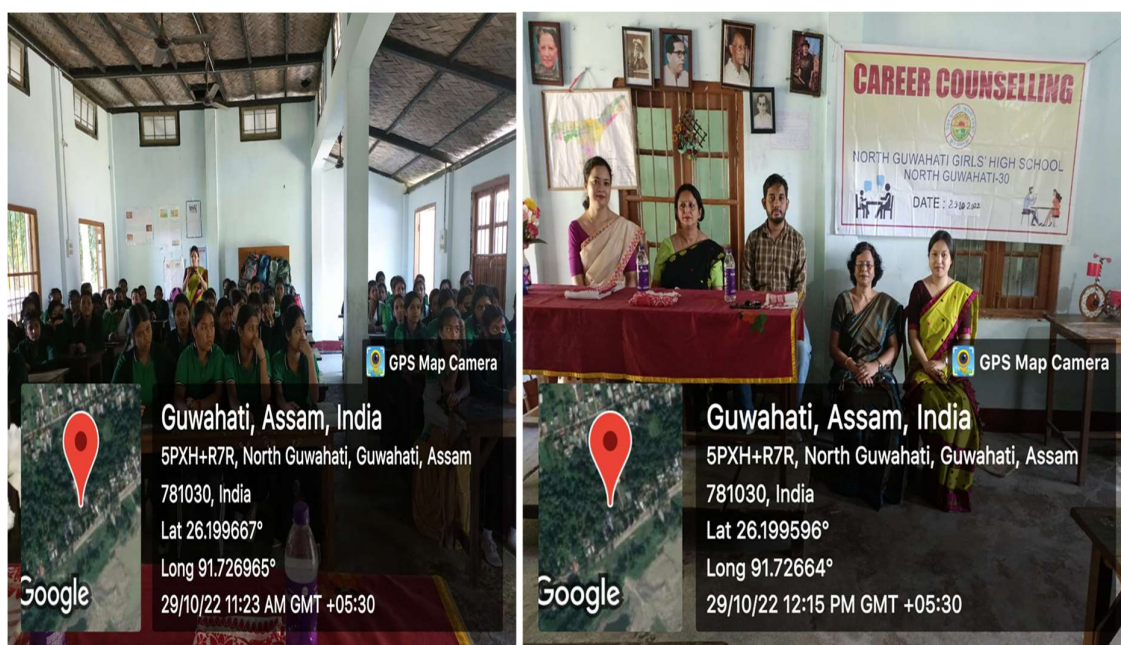
The Career Counseling Cell, NGC, held a one-day Career Guidance Workshop at AKHS Institution, North Guwahati on 27.08.2022. Mr. Anupam Thakuria, Advisor of the Cell and Dr. Sanghamitra Sarma, Convenor of the same represented North Gauhati College and gave an insightful presentation to the students of AKHS Institution on different career opportunities that students can take up after completion of high school. The workshop also included an interactive session at the end where the students of different ages participated and posed different career related queries to the Career Counseling team of North Gauhati College.



2. Career Counselling Session at North Gauhati Girls HE School (29.10.2022)
