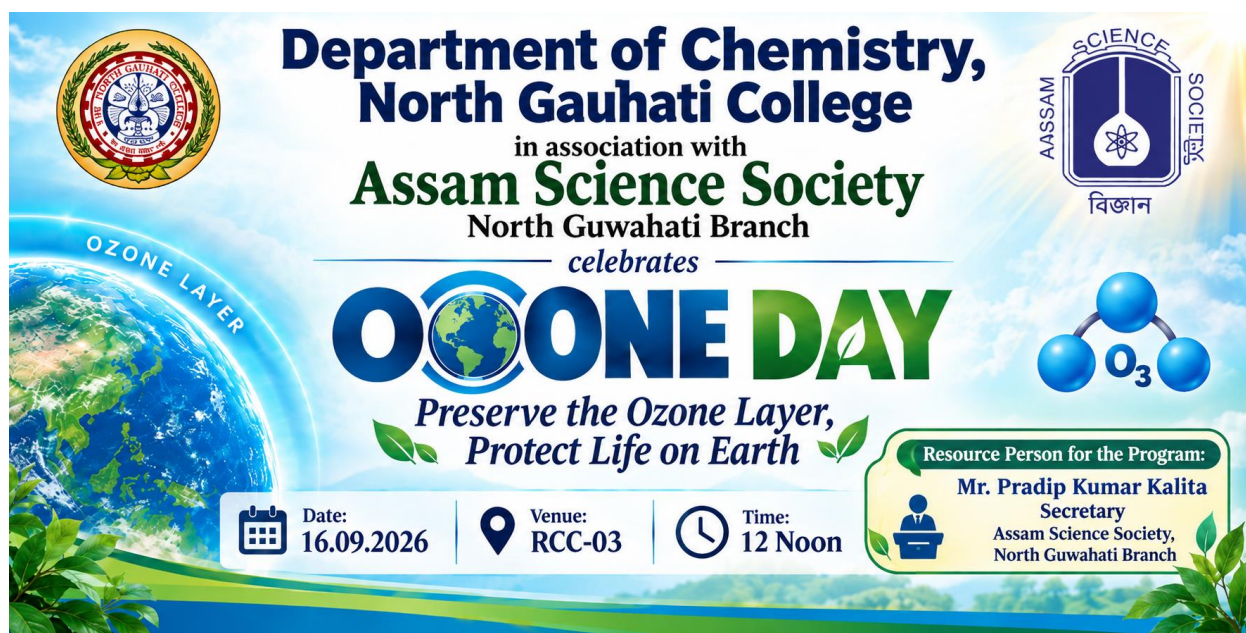


Report on the Observation of World Ozone Day

Date: 16.09.2026

The Department of Chemistry, North Gauhati College, in association with the Assam Science Society, North Guwahati Branch, organized a programme to observe World Ozone Day on 16 September 2026. The programme aimed to create awareness among students about the importance of the ozone layer, the causes of its depletion, and the measures necessary for its protection.

The programme commenced with Mr. Raj Das, who initiated the programme by welcoming the participants and highlighting the significance of observing World Ozone Day. He emphasized the need to spread awareness about environmental conservation and the collective responsibility of protecting the Earth's atmosphere.
