
Subject: Conduct of AEC/VAC/MDC/SEC Papers in Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) from May-June 2026 examination onwards.

Sir/ Madam,

This is to inform you that, for smooth conduct and early declaration of results of all the semester examinations of Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP), it has been decided that –

1. The End Semester examinations of AEC/VAC/MDC/SEC papers of all semesters (wherever applicable) in Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) will be conducted by the Colleges/Institutions from May-June 2026 examination onwards.
2. A separate examination schedule will be prepared and notified by the respective Colleges/ Institutions for the conduct of the examinations for the aforesaid papers which must be completed before the last date of the respective Examination schedule to be published by Gauhati University.
3. After completion of the examinations, all the answer scripts of AEC/VAC/MDC/SEC of all the semesters (wherever applicable) will be evaluated in the respective Colleges/Institutions.
4. Marks for the AEC/VAC/MDC/SEC need to be uploaded in the SAMARTH portal by the Colleges/Institutions within the last date, to be notified from time to time.
5. Evaluation will be done by the teachers of the respective colleges. Remuneration to the answer script Evaluators and Scrutinizers will be paid by the Colleges/ Institutions as per existing G.U. rates.
6. An additional amount of Rs. 100/- per student as AEC/VAC/MDC/SEC examination fees is to be paid by the examinees in their respective colleges along with other fees, as applicable, during the time of filling the examination forms. The amount (Rs. 100/- per student) will be retained by the Colleges/ Institutions to meet the expenses of conduct and evaluation of the aforesaid papers.
7. In order to ensure accountability and transparency, a zonal squad team will be deployed by the University to Colleges/Institutions to monitor fair conduct and evaluation of these papers and will submit a report to the University.
8. To address grievances/RTIs pertaining to evaluation of the aforementioned papers, Colleges/Institutions must keep the answer scripts in their safe custody till Two years from the date of declaration of results.
