

A report on celebration of “World Ozone Day” by Eco Club, North Gauhati College.

Event organized: Poster making competition and Informative talk.

Date: 16/09/2025 (Tuesday).

Venue: RCC-2 and RCC-3.

The Eco Club of North Gauhati College observed “World Ozone Day” on 16th September 2025 (Tuesday), in association with NCC and NSS, North Gauhati College and Assam Science Society, North Guwahati Branch. The event was sponsored by ASTEC, Govt. of Assam. The event was organized with the aim of spreading awareness about the Ozone layer, its significance and protective measures to keep it intact for the safety of the present as well as the future generations to come. Dr Ipsita Bhattacharjee, Co-ordinator, Eco Club, North Gauhati College, started off the informative talk session with welcoming the gathering and stating the relevance of observing “World Ozone Day” with active participation of school and college students as the future generations need a deep understanding on this topic.

A poster making competition was organized amongst school and college students in two groups- (A) for students of classes VIII to XII of nearby schools and (B) for students of undergraduate classes of the college, with the central theme, “From Science to Global Action”. Dr Runumi Devi, Vice Principal, North Gauhati College flagged off the Poster Making Competition with a brief description on the importance of observing “World Ozone Day” in educational institutions as part of raising awareness amongst the youngsters. The event saw a good turnout of students from nearby schools, viz. North Guwahati Girls’ High School and A.K.H.S Institution, along with students of North Gauhati College. Participation certificates were provided to all the participants while trophies were awarded to the best three posters from each of the groups.

3rd Prize: Karishma Barooah, B.A 5th Semester (Deptt. of Geography, NGC).

The second part of the event included an informative talk delivered by Mr. Prabhat Sarma, Retired Associate Professor, Deptt. of Geography, North Gauhati College and President, Assam Science Society, North Guwahati Branch, and Mr. Pradip Kumar Kalita, Associate Professor and Head, Deptt. of Chemistry, North Gauhati College. The program was presided over by Dr Runumi Devi, Vice-Principal, North Gauhati College. While Mr. Sarma gave an informative talk on Ozone layer depletion and how conscious human activities can keep this layer intact, Mr. Kalita gave an elaborate digital presentation on Ozone layer depletion, its harmful effects and how human actions can help in the healing of the Ozone layer, so that the future generations can be safe from harmful radiations of the Sun. The session ended with the vote of thanks delivered by Dr Sanjoy Pathari, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, North Gauhati

College. The Eco Club of North Gauhati College intends to keep on organising such events in the future as well, to keep spreading awareness on important environmental concerns.

A total of 24 participants took part in the Poster Making Competition (including nearby schools and the college) and a total of 41 participants (including faculty members and students) were present in the informative talk session.

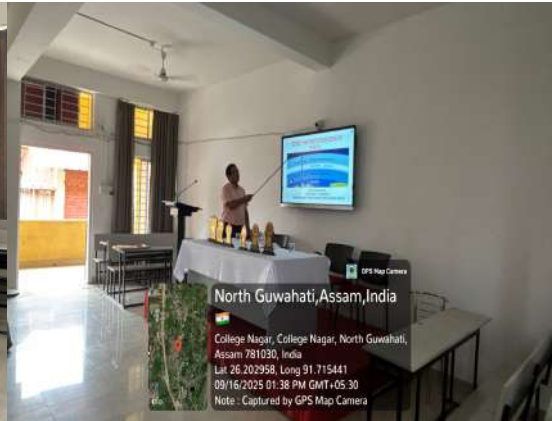
