

# FOUR YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME (FYUGP) IN ARTS AND SCIENCE

As per the National Education Policy (NEP) guidelines of Gauhati University, North Gauhati College is offering Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP) from the session 2023-2024. In line with NEP 2020 Guidelines, FYUGP structure is composed of different Choice Based Courses. The Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) of Gauhati University is as per UGC's Curricular Framework, published in November 2022. The course structure of FYUGP is built on the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS). The FYUGP is basically a CBCS course which does not differentiate between so-called Honours and Pass courses existing under CBCS. Basically, the FYUGP is based on the system of education under Liberal Arts.

The subjects offered in North Gauhati College are as follows:

## **VOCATIONAL COURSES**

North Gauhati College has been offering three year (six semesters) Bachelor Degree Course in Vocational Studies (B.Voc) since 2015 in collaboration with the National Skills Development Council (NSDC). The college is presently offering a course in **Tourism and Hospitality Management.** The B.Voc Degree is recognised by UGC and is affiliated to Gauhati University. A special feature of the course is that there are multiple exit points. Here, a student who opts to leave the course at the end of the first year is awarded a Diploma, a student who opts to exit at the end of two years is awarded an Advanced Diploma, and upon completing three years, one is awarded the B.Voc Degree. The course has earned wide popularity among students due to the fact that the central and the state governments have laid much emphasis on skills development in their recent policies.

The college has a separate campus for B. Voc. and skill development courses with well-equipped classrooms, computer laboratory and other infrastructural facilities. The placement records of students pursuing this course have been quite satisfactory. The department has trained and qualified faculty members appointed both on regular and part time basis. Students of Tourism and Hospitality department go for on-job training to Prashanti Lodge (Government) and CN Travel (Private).

## **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

The Academic procedure is conducted according to the directions of H.S. Council and Gauhati University. All form fill-ups will be done through online mode only. Admissions will strictly be done on the basis of merit, supplemented by the parameters decided by the college authority. The decisions of the Admission Committee regarding admission are final. Any pressure or interference from any quarter for admission of a particular student will result in forfeiture of the claim. All admissions are provisional and subject to the approval of the AHSEC/G.U. The college will not be responsible if AHSEC/GU does not approve of the admission of any student on grounds like lacking migration certificate, eligibility criteria, or for furnishing wrong or false documents, etc. On the day of admission, candidates are required to produce ORIGINAL documents along with one set of Photostat copy (date and time of admission to be notified on the college website). The list of documents to be produced is given below:

- ✓ Mark sheet(s) and Certificate(s) of the last qualifying examination(s).
- ✓ Caste certificate, if applicable.
- ✓ Income certificate, if applicable.
- ✓ EWS certificate, if applicable
- ✓ Unique ID number
- ✓ ABC ID (FYUGP only)
- ✓ Gap Certificate, if applicable

All candidates must submit attested copies of all the documents mentioned above at the time of submission of Admission form. Students belonging to SC, ST (P), ST ((H), OBC and MOBC categories must also submit attested copy of the certificate from the competent authority

## **Fee Structure:**

The admission fee structure will be decided as per Government regulations and will be notified in the college website.

### **Reservation:**

The provisions for reservation of seats for students belonging to SC, ST, OBC, MOBC and Specially-abled categories are in accordance with the rules of the State Government. Students opting to avail reservation facilities will have to produce relevant certificates and other corroborating documents from competent authorities. In both H.S. 1<sup>st</sup> year and TDC 1<sup>st</sup> year, 10 seats are reserved for students having records of outstanding performance in sports, cultural activities, NCC and others. Employee quota provision is also applicable for admission. Requisite documents have to be submitted by the students along with the application form.

#### **GENERAL RULES:**

The college emphasizes on fostering discipline and character building amongst students. Students admitted to the college must abide by the rules and regulations prescribed by the college authority. The Discipline Committee oversees and ensures that there is no breach of regulations, and investigates and takes necessary steps if breaches are noticed and/or reported. Violation of rules, unsatisfactory progress in academics, irregular attendance, irregular clearance of college dues, showing discourtesy to any member of the college fraternity in any forms, adoption of unfair means during examination etc. are some of the offences which may lead to termination of scholarships and even expulsion from the college. Any form of ragging in the college campus is strictly prohibited. The courses of study in the College are full time courses. No students can take any other full time course simultaneously in and outside the institution. Students' societies and associations shall have to abide by the rules and regulations prescribed by the college administration. Only those societies and associations recognized by the Head of the Institution shall have the facilities of the college premises. Any notice desired to be circulated by the students anywhere in the college will need the prior approval of the college authority. The decision of the Discipline Committee shall be final in all matters pertaining to the upholding of discipline. Tobacco, alcohol and any other kind of substance abuse in any form is prohibited in the campus. It is mandatory for all students to wear the college uniform and Identity Card within the college campus.

## **Examination Rules:**

The Examination Cell of the college conducts all examinations. The Cell follows the guidelines received from Gauhati University for Undergraduate courses and Assam Higher Secondary Education Council for Higher Secondary courses. It strictly adheres to college examination and promotion rules.

### **Attendance:**

75% attendance in all subjects is compulsory for students to appear in final examinations. The students must submit their percentage of attendance at office during the time of filling up of their Examination forms. They are to collect their percentage of attendance from their respective Departments, duly signed by the HOD.





The North Gauhati College Library is rapidly growing to be one of the leading regional level academic libraries in the north bank of Brahmaputra. The library was established way back in 1962. There are separate reading rooms for students and teachers. The documents in the library are well arranged. The library is well equipped with a good number of text books, reference materials, xerox facilities, internet with fully open access facilities automated with the help of libraryoriented software SOUL 2.08 (software for university library) network version. All bibliographic details of books, journals and CDROM databases are accessible through the computer. It has a good number of journals (National and International) and magazines. Besides these, the different national and local newspapers (daily and weekly) are available to the user community. North Gauhati College library adequately caters to the needs of the students and teaching community. It offers an environment conducive to learning and for intellectual enquiry by providing user focused services to obtain and access scholarly information and knowledge. The library remains open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on all working days. It offers essential and specialized information, resources and services to meet the growing information needs by-

- ✓ Developing user based resources
- ✓ Organizing information resources
- ✓ Providing human and technology moderated access to information Facilitating users to identify, locate, obtain and access information
- ✓ Every department has its own library, where sufficient numbers of books related to the courses of study are available.

## **Services**

The main service in the college library is book lending. Books and journals are purchased as per the requirement of the students and teachers. Basically the following services are provided to the users of the North GauhatiCollege Library –

Besides these services, North Gauhati College Library has introduced the NList and Internet facilities. The College Library introduced Online Readers' attendance and Institutional Repository through DSpace and College Webportal also.

The library staffs assist the students in locating books and reference materials.

The library has a feedback form for its users, where they can give their suggestions or opinions for the improvement of the library resources, which is analyzed in the Library Committee meeting with principal as its head.

#### **ADD ON FACILITIES:**

**Hostel**: Two Girls' hostel have been constructed in the college campus, with the financial assistance of UGC. It has been functional since August 2015. The accommodation capacity of the hostel is 24. Students have to fill up separate admission form in order to apply for hostel seat.

NCC: The College has N.C.C. units for both boys and girls in separate wings. A candidate can enroll as a cadet after filling up the required forms available with the teacher in charge concerned. A substantial number of NCC cadets have scaled great heights. The mission of Senior Division (SD) NCC platoon is to build the students up as responsible citizens with adequate knowledge of discipline, self-defense training, knowledge about disaster management, social responsibilities etc.

**NSS:** The College has an NSS cell. A candidate can enrol as a volunteer by filling up required form available with the Programme Officer of the College. The NSS programme officer is selected from amongst the teaching faculty. Every year, the enrolment drive programme for NSS student volunteers is organised in the month of August at the college campus when the session begins. Along with the regular activities, the volunteers actively participate in different activities.





## **Career Counselling and Guidance Cell:**

The Career Guidance Cell of North Gauhati College has been organizing various workshops, career fairs, personality development camps and orientation programmes on a regular basis for the benefit of the students. It also imparts counseling on various career options that a student should take up after Higher Secondary or graduation. In the session 2022-2023, the Cell has held a job fair for the students, where regional and national companies offered placements to students. Besides, keeping in tune with the objective of enlarging the scope of its objectives and engaging the community as well, the Cell has conducted career guidance workshops in nearby schools.

For the benefit of the students belonging to SC/ST category, the Cell has held orientation programme with the National Career Service Centre (NCSC) for SC/ST, Government of India to make them aware of different free stipendiary training schemes. The Cell also collaborates with premier coaching institutes to prepare students for different competitive examinations.

The National Career Service Centre (NCSC) for SC/ST, Guwahati, Directorate General of Employment, Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India conducts different training free stipendiary schemes which the SC/ST students can avail of. In this connection, it has collaborated with the Career Counseling Cell of North Gauhati College to hold an orientation program with the students. The training schemes aims to increase the skill set of the students while empowering them with technical knowledge and preparing them to acquire jobs at different levels.

## **Students Union:**

The College has a union for students. The other office bearers i.e., Vice-President, General Secretary and other Secretaries are elected by students from among themselves for one year term. The student union election is held during the month of September of each academic session. The Union body looks into the grievances of the students and places them before the authority for solution. It is entrusted with the responsibility of conducting student related functions and extracurricular activities. Any student willing to contest for getting elected to the Students' Union Body must have 75% attendance in the classes. All powers regarding the election is vested on a committee constituted by the Principal for the purpose. Members of the Students Union Body annually organize different events like Freshman Social, Saraswati Puja and College week (Sports, music, literature, art, dance etc. Competition)
