Seminars and Workshops



North Gauhati College regularly organizes regional and national-level seminars and workshops to promote academic growth among students and faculty. Institutional Advanced Laboratory



The College's Advanced Lab, formerly known as the Biotech Hub and initially funded by the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Government of India, has been actively engaged in teaching and providing hands-on training programs in various fields of Life Sciences for the students since its establishment.

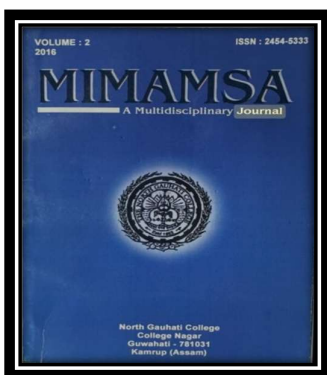


Remote Sensing and GIS Laboratory

The College houses a GIS Laboratory equipped with ArcGIS software, which facilitates studies and research in earth sciences, hydrology, and water resources through the use of remote sensing and GIS techniques.

Language Laboratory

The UGC-funded language laboratory enhances students' English communication skills through interactive practice in speaking, listening, reading, and comprehension. It also supports academic writing by teaching students how to access research databases, use plagiarism detection and grammar tools, and format their work effectively. Additionally, the lab is used for screening films and documentaries to deepen students' understanding of English literature and cultural context.



MIMAMSA Journal

North Gauhati College publishes a Peer Reviewed Multidisciplinary Journal MIMAMSA (ISSN 2454-5333). It is an annual publication that publishes articles on new research findings and scholarly works from various academic disciplines. It serves as a platform for researchers, scholars and practitioners to share their research findings, insights and perspectives. The articles submitted to the Journal are subjected to strict blind peer review by the Editorial Board and by other anonymous reviewers.





The College is equipped with two fully functional computer laboratories designed to support students across various academic disciplines. These labs provide access to a wide range of specialized software applications essential for coursework, data analysis, design projects, programming, and other academic tasks. High-speed internet connectivity ensures smooth and efficient access to online resources, research databases, and collaborative platforms.

In addition, the laboratories are outfitted with modern printing facilities, enabling students to produce high-quality documents, reports, and project materials. Together, these resources create an environment that promotes academic success, supports independent and group research, and fosters technological proficiency crucial for both academic and professional development.



Anthropological Museum

The Department of Anthropology, North Gauhati College houses an Ethnographic Museum that serves as a valuable academic and cultural resource for both the student community and visitors. Established with the aim of documenting and showcasing the diverse heritage of India's tribal and ethnic communities, the museum features a rich and rare collection of material culture, particularly from the indigenous groups of Northeast India.



In addition to ethnographic artifacts, it also displays archaeological findings and local heritage items, offering meaningful insights into the region's historical and cultural identity.



Mushroom Cultivation Technology Unit



The Department of Botany has created a Mushroom Cultivation Technology Unit to promote skill-based education and self-employment. The unit combines academic knowledge with hands-on training, offering workshops on the entire mushroom production cycle, from spawn preparation to harvesting and packaging. The Certificate Course in Mushroom Cultivation, open to both students and community members, provides practical and theoretical training. With three successful courses completed, the program equips participants with employable skills, supports sustainable agriculture, and fosters community development through mushroom-based micro-enterprises.

Vermicompost Production Unit

The Department of Botany's Vermicompost Production Unit promotes skill development and environmental responsibility. Students gain hands-on experience in creating organic manure from biodegradable waste using earthworms. Through training and workshops, they learn the full process and engage in sustainable waste management. This initiative enhances the curriculum, fosters eco-consciousness, and builds entrepreneurial skills in organic farming and green technologies.



International Leadership Development Programme

The Leadership Development Program, a collaboration between North Gauhati College and UMA Global Inc., continues to provide students with global exposure and key skills. Coordinated by **Dr. Jewelina Chowdhury** and led by **Dr. Rita Kakati Shah** (President, Uma Global, New York), the first phase (June 18-28, 2024) included six online sessions covering leadership, communication, entrepreneurship, sustainability, and gender equality, with certificates upon completion. To build on this, UMA Global has launched monthly one-hour virtual mentoring sessions from October 2024 to May 2025, in collaboration with King's Business Club at King's College London. These sessions strengthen student empowerment and cross-cultural learning through UMA Global's flagship Leadership Development Program.

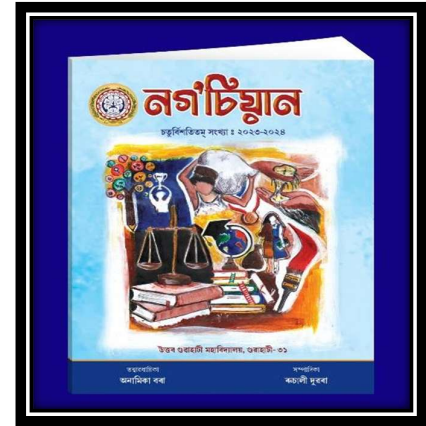
❖ College Week

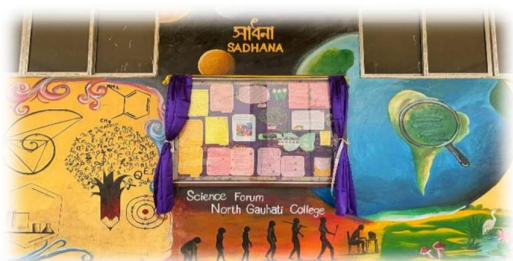
❖ North Gauhati College Students' Union (NGCSU)

Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) Under NEP 2020

North Gauhati College has implemented the Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) leading to Bachelor's Degree in Arts and Science from the session 2023-24. The College is affiliated to Gauhati University and follows the Four Year Undergraduate Programme GU-FYUGP introduced by the University as per regulations of NEP 2020 and UGC.

In line with NEP 2020 Guidelines, FYUGP structure is composed of different Choice Based Courses. The Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) of Gauhati University is as per UGC's Curricular Framework, published in November 2022. The course structure of FYUGP is built on the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). Though the FYUGP is basically a CBCS, it is radically different from the courses running under CBCS. Namely, it does not differentiate between so-called Honours and Pass courses existing under CBCS. Basically, the FYUGP is based on the system of education under Liberal Arts.

General Admission Rules

ELIGIBILITY:

- **Higher Secondary (HS):** A candidate must pass HSLC examination from the Board of Secondary Education, Assam, or equivalent examination recognized by Assam State School Education Board.
- **Four Year Degree Programme (FYUGP):** A student who has passed 12th standard or equivalent examination in any stream from a recognized institution.

PROCEDURE:

❖ **HIGHER SECONDARY**

- The admission to Higher Secondary (Science/Arts) 1st year will be conducted via the common Admission Portal “**DARPAN**” of ASSEB www.darpan.ahseconline.in as per Government Notification.
- The Selected students’ list will be uploaded in the DARPAN portal as well as on the College website.
- Upon selection students will need to approve the institution through their DARPAN login and take admission in the College within the stipulated time period.
- Students must bring their **original and self-attested copies** of all the relevant documents on the day of their admission for verification.

❖ **FOUR-YEAR DEGREE PROGRAMME (FYUGP)**

- Admission to the 1st semester of FYUGP (Science/Arts) will be carried out through the common Admission Portal on the “**SAMARTH**” platform, accessible at <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>, as per Government Notification.
- The online application form must be filled out completely and submitted by the specified deadline on the “**SAMARTH**” portal.
- The Selected students’ list will be uploaded in the SAMARTH portal as well as on the College website.
- Applicants must bring the required documents in **original and self-attested copies** on the day of their admission for verification.

ADMISSION GUIDELINES:

1. The application form for admission to various courses must be submitted online in the prescribed format within the specified deadline, as notified in advance.
2. The merit lists will be published on the College Notice Board/Website well before the admission date.



3. The admission process will be conducted offline at the College on the dates to be announced in due course.
4. Admission will be granted purely based on merit.
 - a) For admission to the FYUGP, the preference for Major subjects will be considered, and admission will be based on the marks obtained in the Best Three Subjects of the qualifying examination.
 - b) If a student chooses not to select any Major subject (i.e., No Major), admission will be based on the preferred subject combinations. The merit list will be prepared based on the Best Three Subjects.
 - c) To be eligible for admission to any programme under the FYUGP, students must meet the prerequisites set by Gauhati University. For more details, refer to the Information Booklet on GU FYUGP (<https://nep.gauhati.ac.in/fyugp/navigate>).
 - d) Students must bring the original and self-attested copies of all the required documents and the completed admission form in person.
 - e) All prospective students wishing to enroll in the GU-FYUGP must be registered with the Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) and obtain a 12-digit ABC ID through the Digilocker Platform (<https://digilocker.meripehchaan.gov.in>) Or APAAR ID before admission. The ABC ID/APAAR ID will be required either during registration or when downloading the First Semester Admit Card.
 - f) Candidates must generate a Unique ID via the web portal of the Director of Higher Education, Assam.
5. Students must upload self-attested copies of the following documents during online form submission, and the original documents must be presented for physical verification:
 - HSLC admit card / certificate for proof of age.
 - HSLC mark sheet.
 - Original mark sheet of last examination passed.
 - Original certificate from the Head of the institution last attended.
 - Gap certificate (in case, the student has passed the qualifying exam earlier).
 - Caste certificate (in case of SC/ ST/ OBC/ MOBC/EWS).
 - Migration / Transfer certificate as the case may be.
 - Certificate of proficiency in co-curricular as the case may be.
 - Parents' Income Certificate (For Free Admission).
 - Certificate of domicile of Assam (As per any document specified by the Govt.).
 - Bank details of the student are a must to get Govt. benefits, if applicable.
6. If a student remains absent for 15 consecutive days from the commencement of regular classes without informing the college authorities or the concerned department, their admission will be canceled without notice, and their seat will be offered to a candidate from the merit list.
7. Degree students must select one of the three core subjects for pursuing a Major/Honours.



8. Admission to the **Girls' Hostel** will be conducted right after the College admission process. A separate application must be submitted in the prescribed format. Hostel admission will be strictly based on merit.

The FYUGP Admission Process of North Gauhati College will be as per State Govt. rules as well as Gauhati University instructions. Students are asked to frequently visit the Gauhati University website for latest updates

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS SEEKING FREE ADMISSION:

- Selection for the free admission category will be strictly in accordance with Government regulations.
- A student is eligible for free admission at one institution only.
- Free admission to Undergraduate Programmes (Arts and Science) does not guarantee a specific subject combination or Honours in any particular subject as requested by the student.
- The College authority holds the final decision regarding free admission, and their decision will be binding.

RESERVATION RULES:

- Seats will be reserved in accordance with the Govt. of Assam rules for candidates from Assam. In this regard, only caste certificates issued by the competent authority under the Govt. of Assam will be considered valid.

Important Information for Students

❖ IDENTITY CARD

- An identity card will be provided to each student upon admission to the College. The card will include the student's details, along with a recent passport-sized photograph, duly signed by the Principal.
- The Identity Card is non-transferable. Students are required to carry their Identity Card at all times and must present it when requested.

❖ LIBRARY MEMBERSHIP

Library membership is mandatory for all students. The membership forms must be submitted to the librarian after admission.

❖ EXAMINATIONS

The College conducts examinations in line with the College Academic Calendar for both Higher Secondary and Degree programs. Students are required to appear for all exams held by the College during the academic year. The College adheres to the rules and regulations of Gauhati University for Undergraduate Programs. Therefore, student performance is closely monitored through continuous assessment in both theory and practical courses. Internal assessment includes Sessional Examinations, class tests, assignments, seminars, projects, group discussions, field trips, and class attendance. At the end of each semester, an external examination is held according to the University's schedule. The final result will be determined by the combined marks from both internal and external examinations. Students must pass both the internal and external exams separately to be eligible for promotion.

❖ ATTENDANCE

Regular class attendance is mandatory for all students. Those who fail to attend at least **75% of the classes** in each subject will be disqualified from appearing in the final examination. As per Gauhati University guidelines, **20% of the marks** allocated for **internal assessment (IA)** will be awarded based on class attendance.

ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

In conformity with Supreme Court of India judgements and directions, UGC guidelines and State Government Instructions, North Gauhati College is following 'Zero-Tolerance Policy' towards ragging. Any student of North Gauhati College accused and found guilty of ragging, will be severely dealt with, in accordance with the Provisions of the Law.

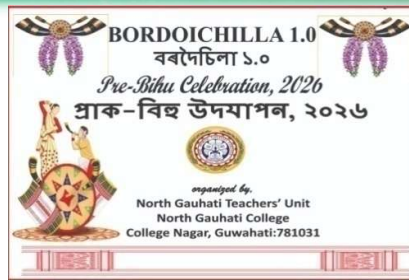
